

Signals continued

e — elephant (ellie elephant): hold two arms down together in front of body. Clasp hands and swing them from side to side as a trunk.

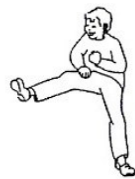
f — fish (francy fish): place the palm of one hand on the back of the other hand to form fish — wiggle thumbs.

g — gorilla (gordo gorilla): simulate peeling a banana, taking a bite, then throwing down the peel.

h — horse (honey horse): slap sides of hips suggesting a horse galloping.

i — inchworm (inny inchworm): using index finger, bend it, then move it back and forth to suggest an inchworm.

j — jellyfish (jerry jellyfish): move arms, hands, shoulders, head in a wiggly, jelly-like fashion.



k — kangaroo (kayo kangaroo): give a kick with one leg. At the same time make two fists and pose as if boxing.



l — lizard (lizzy lizard): place hands on desk or knees. Move head forward and demonstrate a lizard catching a fly with its tongue.



m — mouse (missy mouse): act as a mouse nibbling a small piece of cheese. Wiggle nose.



n — nightowl (nigel nightowl): using thumb and index finger of each hand, make a circle around each eye.



o — octopus (olive octopus): extend each arm outward to sides, using a waving motion to suggest the tentacles of an octopus.



p — penguin (peewee penguin): stiffen arms at sides of body and do a penguin walk, waddling from side to side.
